

IHS ANNUAL REPORT

Good Evening to all of you present here today. I extend a warm welcome to each of our Distinguished Guests, Dignitaries, Parents, school faculty members and students to the school's first ever Annual Function.

The school opened its doors to welcome its first batch of the students in April, 2018. We started with few students and steadily rose to reach the present strength of about 300 students. Not less than a feat for us in our second academic session.

I became a part of this journey when I took over as the Principal on 28th June, 2019. Let me introduce myself though a lot of you know me by now. I am Neelu Sharma. I have over 29 years experience in the field of education and have had the good fortune of being associated with renowned schools across India. To name a few, DPS- Bangalore, DPS, Sec-45, Manav Rachna, Amity International School, Noida,. I worked in the capacity of Principal in MMI and DPS, Sec-84 before taking up this role. Much has been achieved over the last 5 months in IHS. Let me take you through the path travelled by the school.

Honorable Chairman Sir Shri Satpal Dahiyaji had a vision to provide quality education that was accessible to all. Mr. Yogesh Dahiya, the Director and Mr. Sumit Dahiya, the VP shared this dream passionately and so as a first step the foundation stone of the school building was laid in the year 2017. However, the vision took the shape of the school building which was officially inaugurated in January, 2018. A lot of thought has been put into designing the school - be it the unique and aesthetic architecture, its Curriculum, Quality teaching and learning programmes, ergonomically designed classrooms and furniture and the overall vision, mission and philosophy. This required foresightedness and thus the journey began with the school deliberately taking the path which was "less trodden" with the aim to bring in innovations to make the school life an enjoyable, satisfying and complete learning experience for the students.

The school made a conscious decision to implement the CBSE curriculum in the school as it provides for International Benchmarking and standards par excellence in content, delivery, assessments and professional development of the faculty. This curriculum is culturally sensitive, identifies learner's strengths and limitations, supports learning and development. Our curriculum is balanced and caters to holistic development. It lays stress on use of technology in teaching-learning, physical education, visual and performing arts and life skills. As Albert Einstein rightly said, "Education is not learning of facts, but training of mind to think." We believe in training the mind of our young learners.

It gives me immense pleasure to announce that we have got Haryana Board affiliation till Grade XII, which is the first step to apply for CBSE Affiliation. I would like to inform you that we will be applying for CBSE affiliation in January, 2020.

Learning also happens outside a classroom and that is the best form of learning and is called experiential learning. Educational excursions, colour days, rallies taken out by students, debates, role plays, talent shows, presentations, nature walks, special weeks etc are some of the experiential learning methods that we adopt to give wings to our student's thoughts and creativity. Children are encouraged to be aware about their immediate environment around them through activities that integrate art, technology, music and dance. For pre-primary students, activities are designed to develop their fine motor skills and to encourage sensorial development.

We believe in developing the inherent talent of every child and give them exposure in areas that they are interested in and have the potential to excel. To be able to do that, we promote participation in inter-school competitions. Our students, Disha, Grade V & Simran, Grade III participated in a Performing Arts Competition organized by Manav Rachna International School, Sec-21, Faridabad. To display their creativity and ability to innovate, our students are participating in a ROBO-FEST to be organized on 15th December in Euro International School. Such participation is going to be a way of life here at IHS as we will ensure that

students get maximum opportunities to participate in various inter school competitions.

Special Weeks such as book week, heritage week ,science week, math week etc will be celebrated in school to help students develop a fondness for the subjects that they study and make them think out of the box so that each subject becomes a source of inquiry and generates an inquisitiveness to know more and to enable them to enhance their knowledge through various projects, experiments, research and activities.

National and international Olympiad Exams and ASSET exams are conducted in school and students are encouraged to participate. Tivon Kataria of Grade VII has qualified for the next level of ASSET Exam. Congratulations son! The Olympiad results are awaited.

Clubs form an integral part of our school curriculum. From the next academic session, students will be enrolled in different clubs such as theater and public speaking, music, dance, science club, computer club, robotics, sports club as per their interests to develop their creative and cognitive skills.

To encourage healthy competition within the school and to give students an opportunity to participate in different activities, a House System has been devised and will be implemented from the next academic session. This will provide them a platform to raise their self esteem and confidence level apart from giving them opportunities to display leadership abilities and teamwork. The four houses are Leaders, Champions, Challengers and Warriors.

We all know that the students are the future leaders of tomorrow and it is our responsibility to develop them to become responsible citizens. We intend to start this process next session onwards by having a student council with democratically elected council members. This team will be the role model for others and will be expected to efficiently carry out all the duties and responsibilities entrusted on them and display leadership qualities.

Celebrations, in our school are inter-woven with values to reinforce pride among our students for their culture and tradition. Human values such as honesty, compassion, empathy, respect, forgiveness, hard work are the core to human development and the foundation of any civilized society. In a bid to create awareness about the human values that our students must uphold, we have incorporated “Value for the month” wherein one value is discussed, debated for a month to understand the true meaning of that value. We are sure that this effort will pay off when our children will imbibe these

values and become model citizens. Other than that, various initiatives have been undertaken by the school to make students aware of their social responsibilities. Our students participated in plantation drives in the school and also undertook a rally to educate other students and staff about the urgent need for environmental protection. We encourage students to plant a sapling in school on their birthdays as their contribution to save our Earth from further degradation. October was celebrated as the month of sharing and caring for which our students spent time with the special ones from Deep Ashram and played the perfect hosts to them. It was a very humbling experience for them to mingle with the guests and everyone was deeply touched with their visit. Another set of visitors were the students from the local Government School and it was heartening to see our students teach them life skills and also ensured that they had a good time in a 'big school'. We will continue with our efforts in this direction so that our children become empathetic people who care not just about their near and dear ones but the community at large.

The school believes in the motto, "A healthy body is necessary for a healthy mind" and encourages its students to participate in various sporting activities. Our students are exposed to an array of sports like Taekwondo, lawn tennis, basket ball, skating, cricket. Apart from that we are also running sports academies in the school for Lawn Tennis, Shooting and Taekwondo. Next session onwards, we plan to have evening academies for cricket, skating and horse riding. These academies are for students who wish to hone their skills in a particular sport. Our students brought laurels to the school by winning medals in the Sub-Junior category in the Ist Shaheed Chandrashekhar Azad Memorial Shooting Championship held at Muzzafar Nagar. The winning team comprised of:

1. Tanishak Janghu ---- Silver Medal & Team Silver
2. Moksh Rastogi ---- Bronze Medal
3. Dhruv Janghu ---- Team Silver

Our students did us proud by participating in the 31st Delhi State ITF Taekwondo Championship and winning medals. Ayushman Atrey , Grade III, Keshav , Grade V and Aaquib Ali, Grade VII got Bronze Medals and Vidisha Rathore of Grade III got a Silver Medal.
