# **ACTIVITY - 1**

### **My Mini Beast Neighbourhood**

You all read about our neighbourhood in EVS books, similarly mini beasts live together and have their own form of neighbourhood. They have different kinds of habitat, lifestyle and are very important to the nature.

This summer holiday, let's know them more closely. Let's take a walk around the local park and while exploring the outdoors, look for the mini beasts(insects). They are adaptive to live everywhere but in this activity we will focus mainly on those mini beasts that live in the garden.

Let us make a mini garden full of mini beasts and create a mini beast neighbourhood. We can make a mini garden using very simple things and is very interesting to make too. Before we start making the garden let's solve the following riddles and find out who are the little beasts that are going to reside in your little garden.



A riddle is a statement or question that has multiple meanings and needs to be solved.

I am often red with black spots. I have two sets of wings and I love to eat aphids! Who am I?



I wiggle and cannot see. I am long and friendly. Sometimes underground and sometimes on a tree. Who am I?



I am beautiful. I have six legs.

I can fly. I am colourful. What am I?



I am a yellow black insect. A hive is my home. I eat pollen from flowers to make honey comb. Who am I? I am sure the riddle has been very easy to need to follow the steps-



solve! Now let's make their home. For that you

green crepe paper on to the plate with glue.

1. Take a sturdy paper plate and stick

- 2. You can easily break and attach some ice cream sticks on the edges of the paper plate and colour them green which will make them look like tall grasses and on the tip of the sticks using glue you can stick some beautiful handmade flowers.
- 3. You can also put small zigzag cut green paper to add the grass like effect to the garden and add patches of brown paper to give the effect of soil.
- 4. We can join cotton balls and googly eyes, some pebbles to make the above mentioned insects.
- 5. In order to make the pebbles more insect like colour them and by using paper and colour make wings and attach it to them with glue.
- 6. You can stick the insects to the plate to prevent them from falling off the paper plate. And with these simple steps you can easily make a mini home for our mini beasts which will not just look lovely but will also give you an insight of their habitat. I hope you enjoy making this mini beast neighbourhood!

#### **MATERIAL REQUIRED:-**

- a) 2 paper plates
- b) Green paper(1 green A4 sheet / crepe paper)
- c) 3 or 4 ice cream sticks
- d) 5 cotton balls
- e) 2 sets of googly eye
- f) Pebbles(Collect it from any nearby garden and paint them)
- g) White A4 sheet (Cut it in the shape of wings and colour it)




## **Mini Beast Bites**




After you make the mini beast then write the below five points about the mini beast you made in a coloured A4 size sheet and bring to the class and give a class presentation once the holidays are over:

How we can prevent such mini beasts from breeding.(2 points mandatory)


What are the treatments available.( 3 points )






