



Dominic Thiem wins maiden Grand Slam with US Open triumph

ominic Thiem produced a historic comeback to beat Alexander Zverev in a nervy five-setter, and win the US Open on Sunday for his first Grand Slam title. The second seeded Austrian beat the fifth seed, 2-6, 4-6, 6-4, 6-3, 7-6 (8/6) in 4 hours 2 minutes, inside a near-empty Arthur Ashe Stadium.

■ It marked the first time in the US Open's history that a player had recovered from losing the opening two sets to win the title ■ It was also the first time the final had been settled by a tiebreak ■ Thiem is also the first Grand Slam champion other than Novak Diokovic, Rafael Nadal or Roger Federer, since Switzerland's Stan Wawrinka won the third of his majors at the



The House met for nearly 20 minutes in the morning, and was then adjourned for an hour, after paying tributes to the former president Pranab Mukherjee, a sitting MP and 13 former members, who died in the recent past.


IILIO MORALES RUIZ. SPAIN




