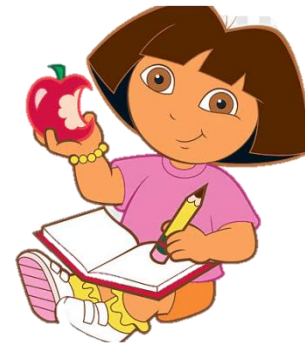


### TASK - 3

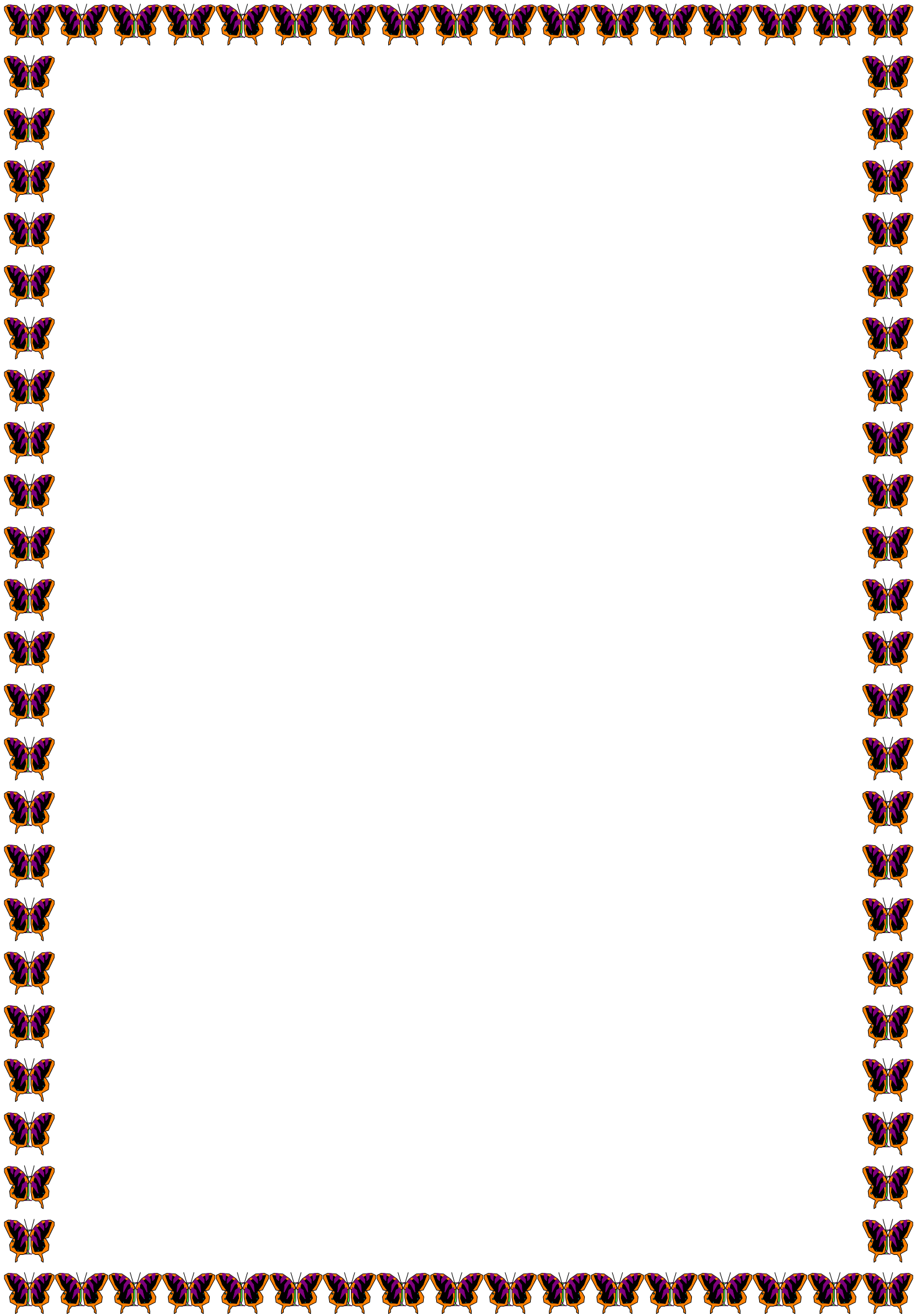

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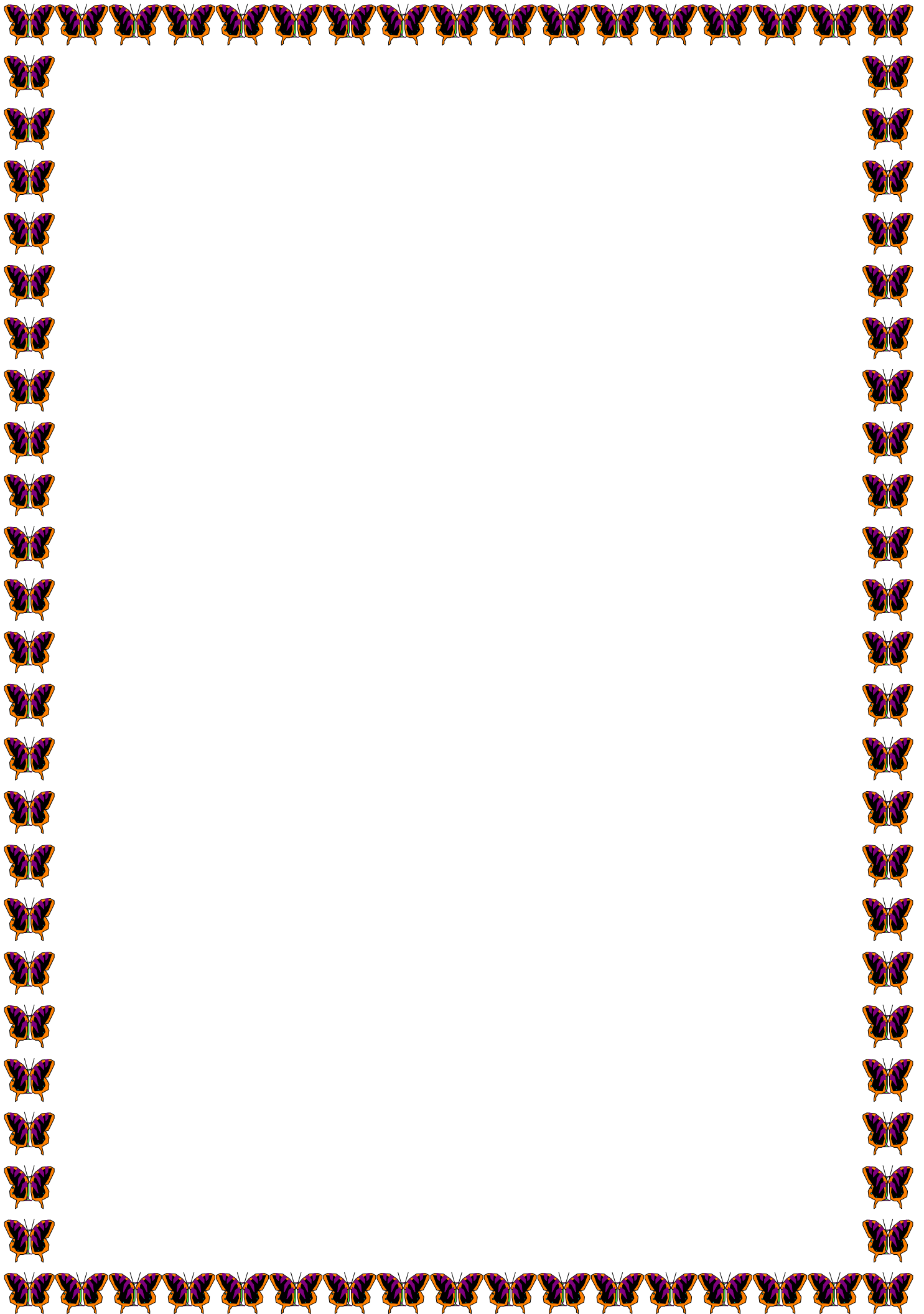

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# Environmental Studies(EVS)

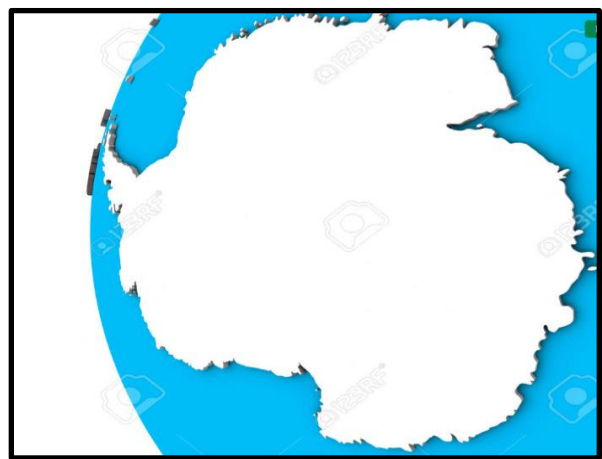

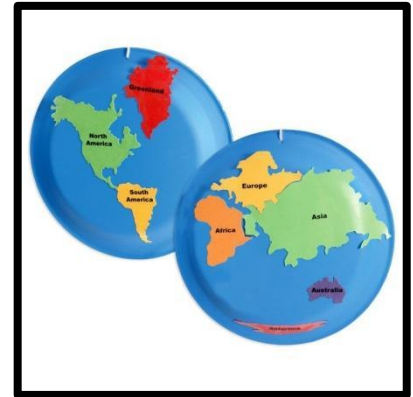
I am sure that needed some brain storming! Now please follow the below steps-

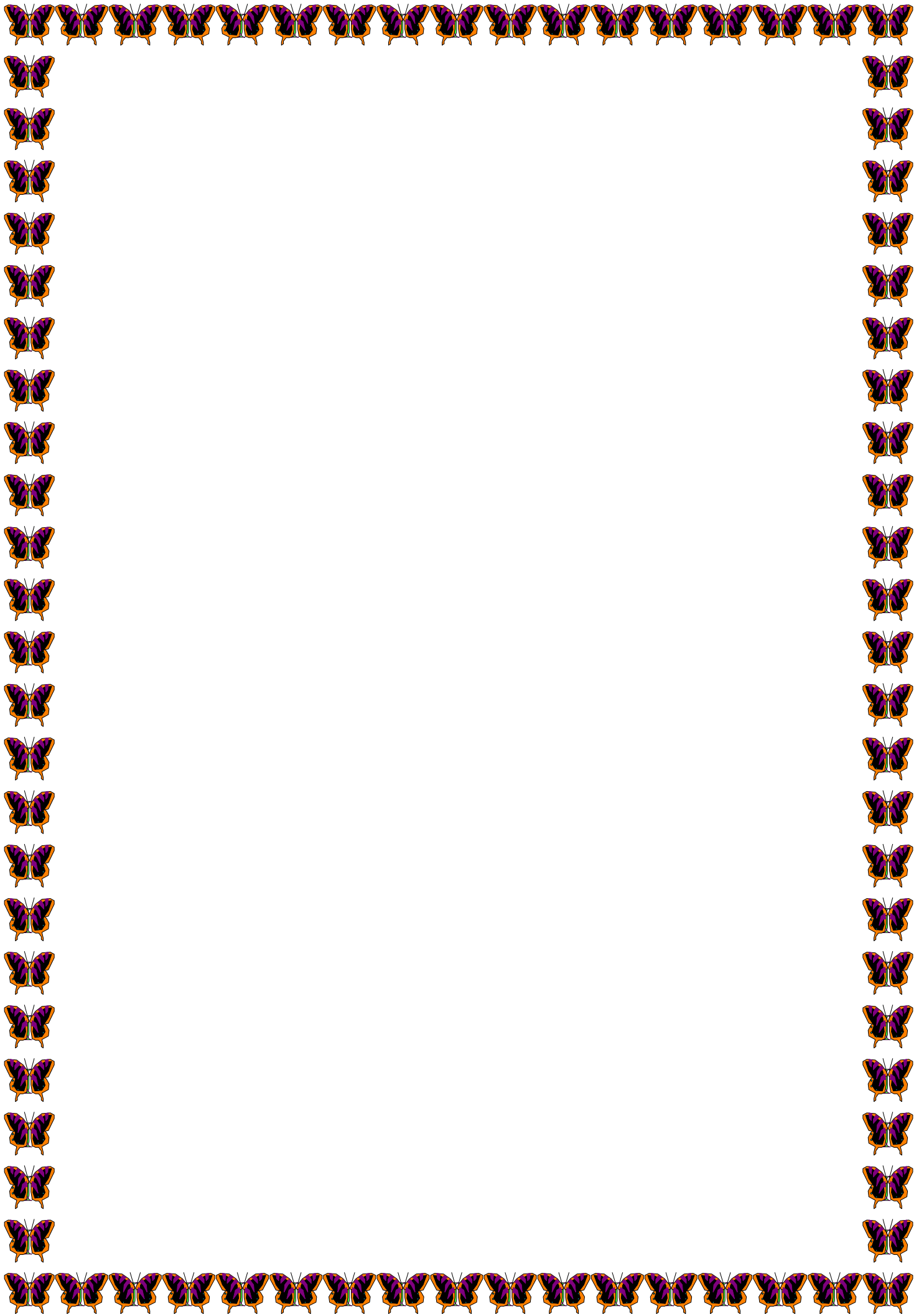

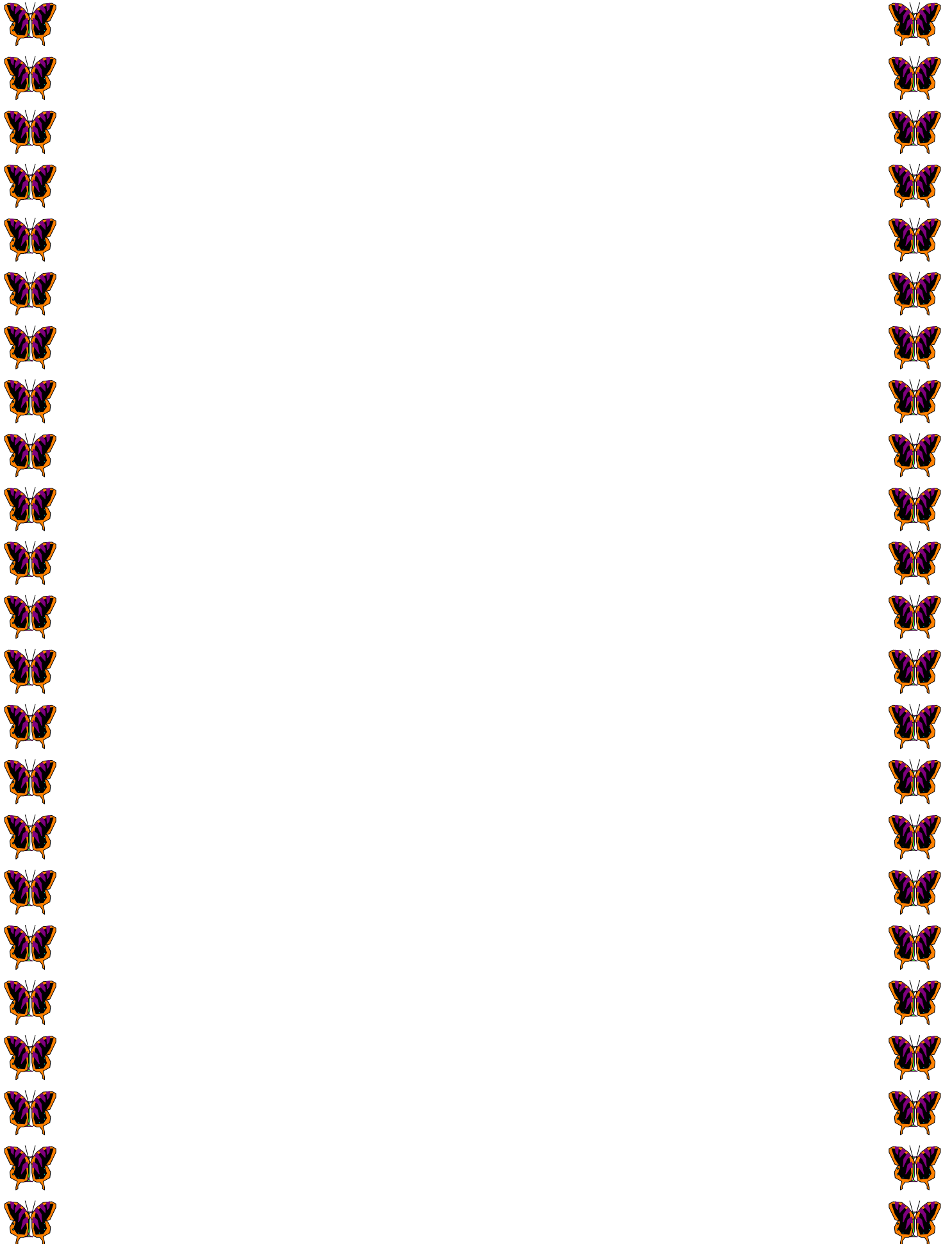
### Steps to make a Laiphadibi Wall hanging~

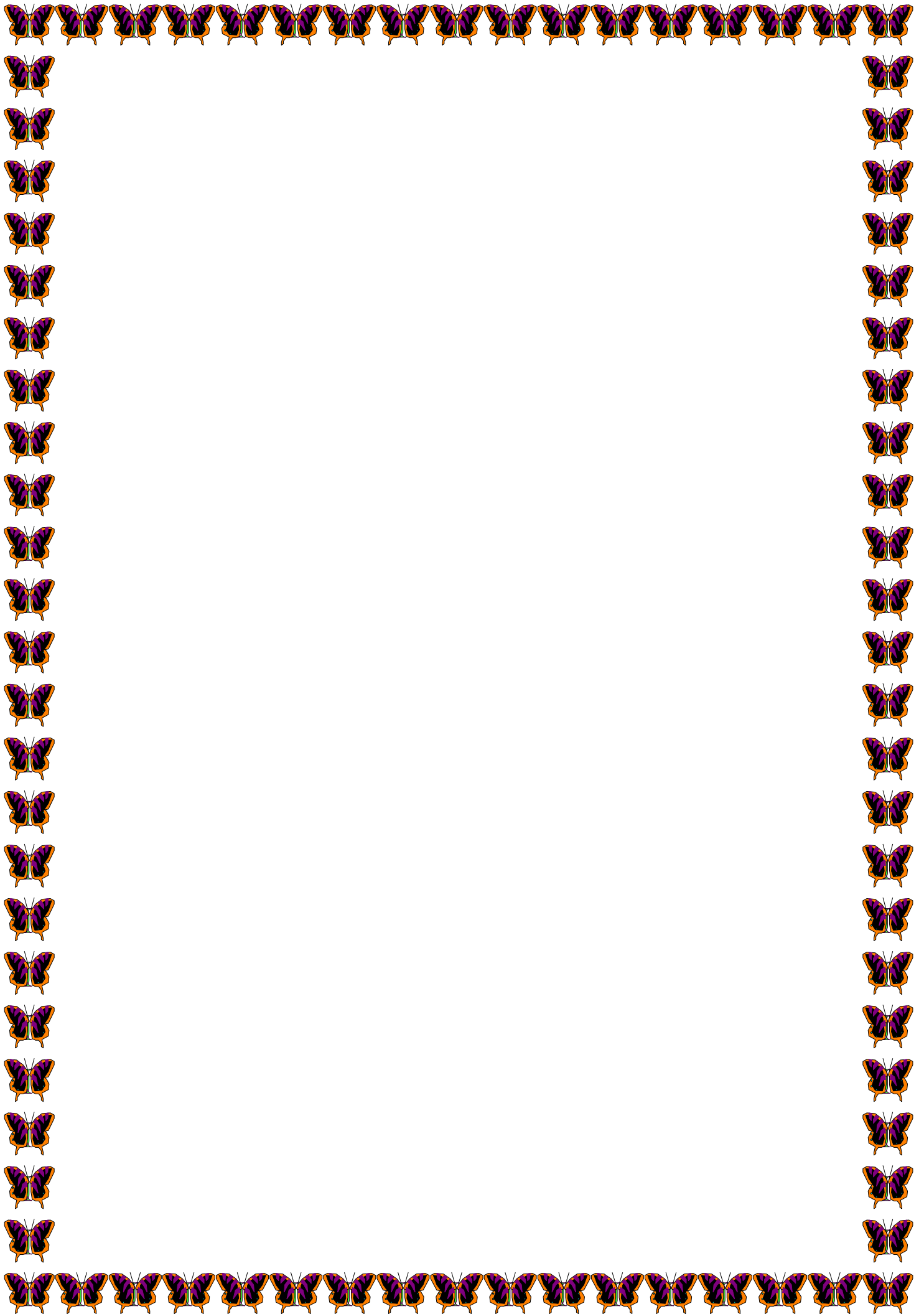

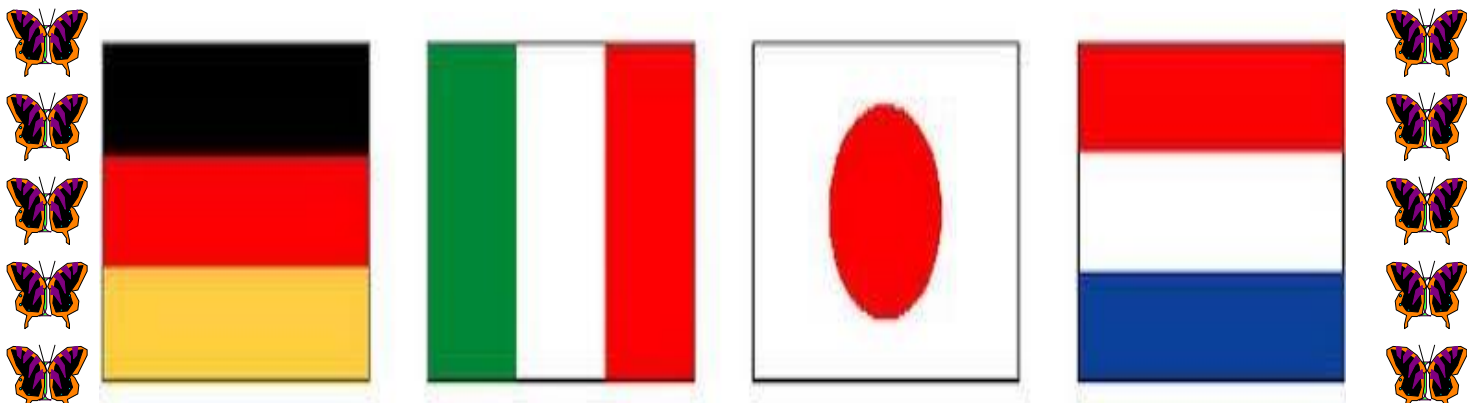
### Steps to create a passport
