

<u>Independent Me</u>

Please give instruction to your ward to do these activities at home....

- Opening and closing tiffin box.
- Zipping and unzipping.
- Proper toilet training.
- Arranging shoes in the shoe rack.

Imbibe 'Social Skills' in your child. Encourage your child to....

- Greet with a smile when someone comes to the house.
- Go out doors and play with his/her friends.
- Converse freely with visitors, relatives coming over to the house.
- Speak politely with all.
- Sit at the dining table with the family to eat meals using proper table manners.
- Respect and help the elders at home.

Let's Converse in English

- May I go to the washroom?
- May I open / close my tiffin / bottle?
- I am hungry. Please give me food.
- I have finished my work / food.
- I am thirsty. May I drink water?

Let's learn about Hygiene.Encourage your child to...

- Brush his/ her teeth twice a day.
- Trim his/ her nails often.
- Keep his/ her surroundings and environment clean.
- Remember that it a bad habit to throw things out of the windows, car or balcony.



- Cook dinner together.
- Go shopping together. Tell your child about the difference between a market and mall, about the things, items and material purchased from there.
- Let your child help in your household chores like cleaning windows, dusting and many more.
- Walk together and talk to your child about what she/he likes, dislikes and why?
- Help your child to memorize the home address and your phone numbers too.

Fun in Knowing: Tell the child about your childhood, share incidents from the past and show her/him old family albums. This will strengthen the bond between you and your child. **Fun with Books:** Read English and Hindi stories to your child with morals and colourfu illustrations

Good manners and good habits are lifelong assets and they should be practiced until they become habit. Revise the four magical words: PLEASE, SORRY, THANK YOU and EXCUSE ME which we have learned as the part of basics of good manners. Make these four magical words a habit and see the difference.



GERMINATION- A JOURNEY OF A SEED TO A PLANT

ACTIVITY -1

Germination is the process by which a seed begins to sprout and grows into a new plant.

Germination is like the wake-up call for a sleeping seed. When a seed gets enough water, warmth, and air, it starts growing. First, a tiny root called a radicle comes out and digs into the soil. Then, a shoot pushes up above the ground, carrying leaves for making food. This whole process of a seed turning into a new plant is called germination.

Let us understand this simple process of germination through a craft activity.



<u>Material required:</u>

- A4 sheet (white)
- Poster colours (green, brown)
- Paint brush
- Glue
- Crayon Yellow

SPROUT CHAAT (GERMINATION)

ACTIVITY -2

A sprout is a young shoot that emerges from a seed during germination. Sprouted chaat is a tasty snack which can be tossed up quickly, and is the perfect answer to sudden hunger pangs.

Look at the picture below and try and make the same one with your parents.



<u>Material required:</u>

- 1 bowl soaked and sprouted whole moong dal
- 1 small onion- finely chopped
- 1 medium tomato finely chopped
- 1 green chilly finely chopped (optional)
- 1 tablespoon chopped coriander leaves Chaat masala powder as required
- 1 or 2 teaspoon lemon juice as per taste Black salt as required

<u>Recipe:</u>


In a large mixing bowl, mix sprouted moong dal, chopped onions, chopped tomatoes, chaat masala, black salt, 1 teaspoon of lime juice, and 1 tablespoon of chopped coriander leaves.


<u>Material required:-</u>
