Heritage Day activity in which the students participated in a Paper Presentation highlighting carbon dating and Half life as an important tool available to scientists who study ancient history.

Environmental Week was held from 19-04-24 to 25-04-24 where following activities were conducted:

- Paper presentation on the topic"Carbon Tax, the new stage in our capitalist world".

-Intra Class Debate competition on the topic 'Organic farming is better than Conventional farming for our environment'

-Inter House Competition in which the students presented Nukkad Natak to spread awareness about the environment among the students.

- One Child, One Plant Campaign was organized wherein the students planted a sapling in the school campus.

To commemorate **World English Day**, an activity- Citizens' forum was conducted in Grade XI, wherein the students were divided into groups and were asked to express their opinions, concerns, and ideas on matters of public interest, thereby empowering them to contribute to positive societal change. This activity helped the students in generating ideas and using language functions appropriately in stating the problems, giving suggestions, concluding and summarizing.

An open debate was organized to celebrate **World Day for Safety and Health of workers**. The topic for the debate was "The government rules cover the safety measures for health workers".

International Labor Day in which students played a friendly cricket match with the bus drivers and attendants.

International Day for Biological Diversity wherein the students designed a Bulletin board about the variety of life on Earth.

In English an activity was conducted with reference to the poem – 'A Photograph' as a part of their Grade XI English curriculum wherein the students were asked to describe an old mounted photograph. The objective of this activity aimed to work on their linguistic skills, and give them the opportunity to express themselves with a range of emotions.

In the **Physics** lab the students performed experiments based on measuring instruments like- vernier callipers and screw gauge.

In **chemistry** Quantitative estimation was done in the lab to find strength of solution of hydrochloric acid by using sodium carbonate solution.

Harsh (Champions House) got first position in the Inter house Nukkad Natak competition.

In an inter school competition held at Suncity school, Anangsha Ghosh secured first position for "AI Innovate challenge" category.

In sports **Rhythm Kataria** secured silver medal and Harsh secured bronze medal in **1st Invitational Athletics championship** held at Buddha International School.
