Dear Parents,

Greetings and welcome back!

The new session started with a settling period for students as they were gradually introduced to the new environment, routines, and classmates. This phase aimed to help children feel comfortable and secure in their new surroundings, fostering a sense of belonging and confidence. Activities during this period focused on building social skills, independence, and familiarity with the daily schedule.

On the academic front, students were introduced to cursive writing through strokes and to the concept of more and less through various activities. The theme in EVS was Me and Myself and the students learned how to introduce themselves. They were keen to speak about themselves during circle time and tried to speak loudly and confidently. They also learned about the five sense organs and were keen to share their prior knowledge on the same. They also made a Five Senses Lapbook with detailed pictures to depict what each sense organ is used for.



During the festive season of Baisakhi, students had a great time creating a personalised dhol and enjoyed dancing on Punjabi tunes to celebrate the festival.

Environment Week was celebrated in the school to make students aware of the importance of protecting and taking care of our environment. Students enjoyed making a personalised 3D Earth craft and discussed the importance of a clean planet. An Awareness Rally by the Pre Primary Wing was organised around the school corridors to promote the feeling of responsibility towards the environment, highlighting small steps that each one of us can do. Students also engaged in a sorting activity of dry waste and wet waste through a Nature Walk that boosted their young minds to the next level. They also learned about the 3 Rs (Reuse, Recycle, and Reduce), saving trees, saving water and using dustbins. An Intra Class Show and Tell Competition on Save water was conducted for students to encourage creativity and emphasize the importance of water conservation in a way that was fun and engaging for them.

The world is full of colours and each colour has a significance. Green Colour Day was celebrated in school where students engaged in discussions and identified green items around themselves. They also spoke about green objects they got from home, most of them carrying something precious to them. They were keen to showcase the same to their teachers and friends. As a takeaway they recycled a paper bag to make a frog and were excited to carry it back home.

On World Dance Day, our young dancers showcased their love for dance with great energy and put up great performances. Celebrating World Family Day, they made hand crafted frames and pasted pictures of their family, proudly introducing each family member. .

Our students enjoyed a vibrant mango party, savouring juicy mangoes and participating in fun-filled activities celebrating the delicious fruit, creating sweet memories together.

Mother's Day was the highlight of the month and mother child duo both enjoyed making mocktail connections over the slurpy activity.
