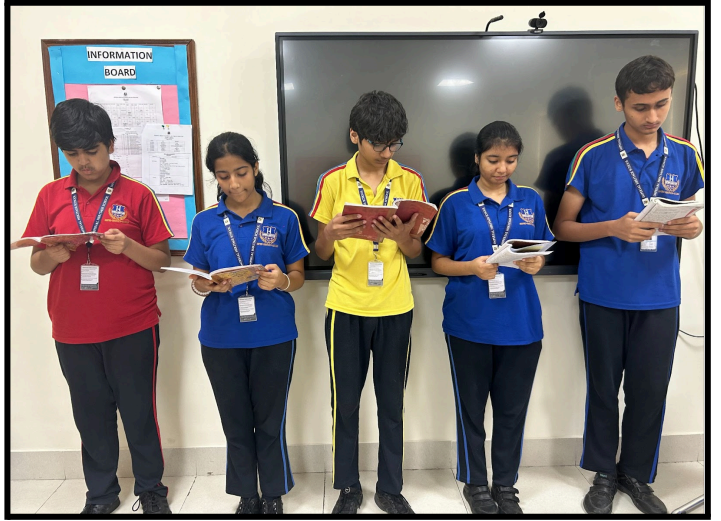
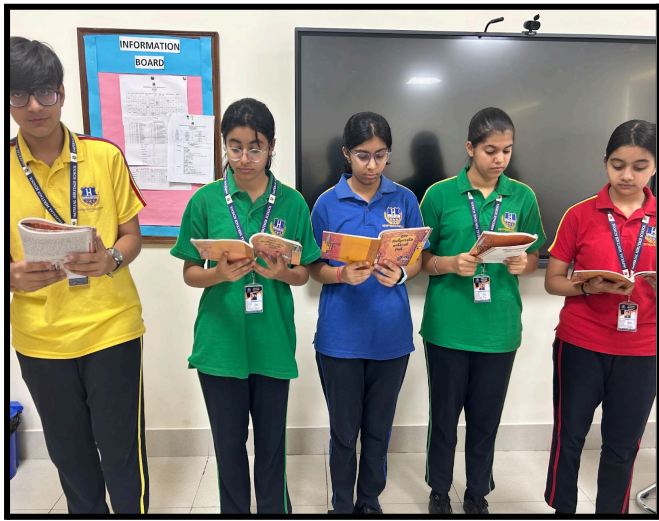
In Physics laboratory students of Grade X performed an experiment of tracing the light rays refracted by a glass prism.
