Career counseling helps the students to understand the relationship between their education and career goals. With this aim a career counseling session was organised for the students along with their parents.

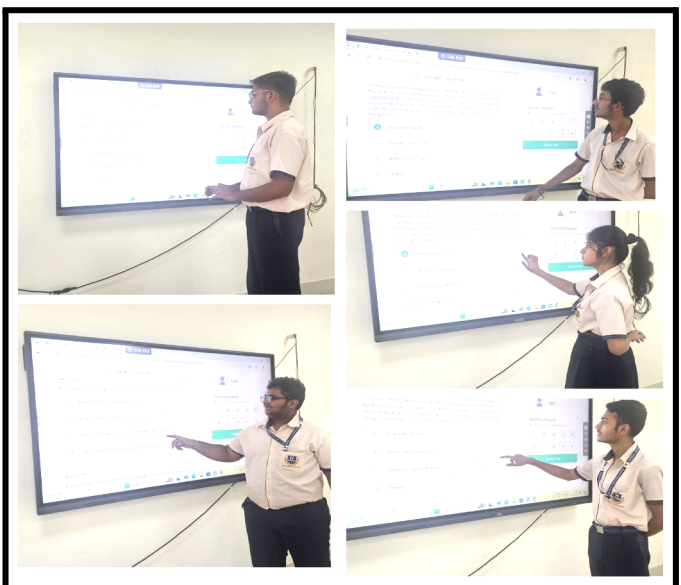
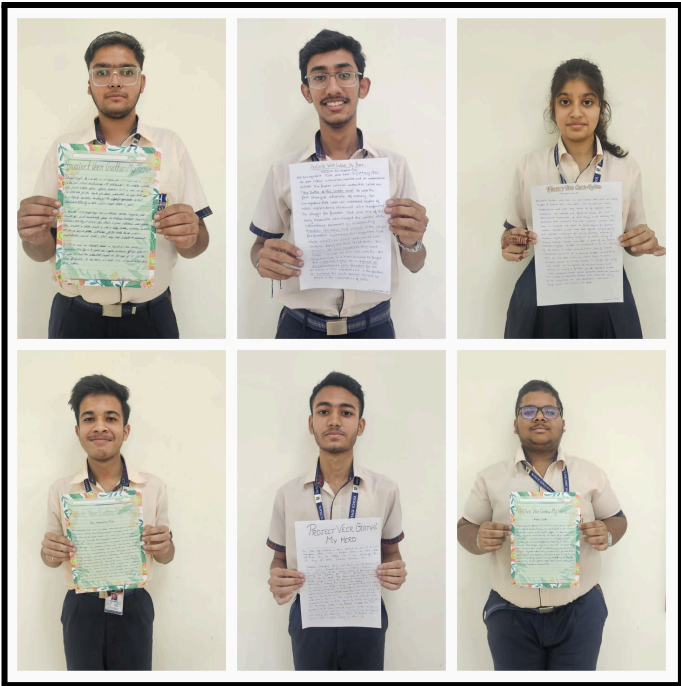
