

In **Chemistry** as a part of experiential learning students have analysed the given salt for acidic and basic radical and also in class under Flip activities students have taken oral expression of the topic learnt. In **Physics** Lab students of Grade XII science performed an experiment to calculate minimum angle of deviation after refraction through a glass prism. There are many alternative therapies which are used as intervention for psychological disorders. In **Psychology** the students were asked to research any one such therapy and present their findings in the class. In **Biology**, students experimentally learnt the various stages of meiosis in onion flower buds or grasshopper testis through permanent slides. They also studied the pedigree charts of genetic traits like rolling of tongue, blood groups, ear lobes, widow's peak, colour blindness.

Values are an integral part of the curriculum at Imperial Heritage School. The value of the month was "PRIDE" Students have participated in discussion on the same. They shared their thoughts on how one should feel pride for imbibing good values as responsible citizens.
